**Products Available with a Prescription:** Corlanor® (ivabradine) tablets, Enbrel® (etanercept), Prolia® (denosumab) injection for Bone Health, Repatha™ (evolocumab), and Sensipar® (cinacalcet) Tablets

**Amgen Safety Net Foundation may be able to help**

Amgen Safety Net Foundation is a nonprofit patient assistance program that helps qualifying uninsured patients access Amgen medicines at no cost.

**Do I qualify for help?**

You may be able to receive Amgen medications at no cost from Amgen Safety Net Foundation if you meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Are a resident of the US or its territories
- Satisfy income eligibility requirements below
- Have no or limited drug coverage
- Do not have any other insurance or financial support options
- For Medicare Part D patients, meet additional criteria

## ENROLLMENT TIP SHEET FOR PRESCRIPTION PRODUCTS - PATIENTS

### How do I apply?

Step 1: Get the Patient Application Form for Prescription Products

- Go to [www.amgensafetynetfoundation.com](http://www.amgensafetynetfoundation.com) and click on the **Forms** tab; or
- Call us at **1-888-762-6436** and have the form faxed or mailed to you

Step 2: Complete the Patient Application Form for Prescription Products

- Fill out the Patient Information (pages 1 and 2 of the application)
- If you are unsure how to fill out any part of this form, you may be able to get assistance from your provider or you can call us at **1-888-762-6436** to speak to one of our agents

Step 3: Sign and date the Patient Certification and Authorization (page 3 of the application)

Step 4: Have your provider submit a prescription

- Your provider can complete the Product Prescription Form (page 4 of the application); or
- Submit an original script
- Your provider will need to fax one of these documents to us at **1-866-549-7239**

Step 5: Send in your completed Patient Application Form

- Review your application and make sure you have filled in all of the required information to avoid any processing delays
- You can ask your provider to fax your application along with your script to **1-866-549-7239**; or
- You can send your application by fax to **1-866-549-7239** or mail to:

### When will I find out if I'm approved?

Once a completed application and any requested supporting documents have been received and processed, you and provider will be notified of the enrollment decision. **Missing information or an incomplete application will delay an enrollment decision.**

### How do I receive my medication?

For Corlanor®, Enbrel®, Repatha®, and Sensipar® once a patient has been enrolled, they will be contacted by Amgen® Safety Net Foundation to provide consent and schedule shipment.

For Prolia® once the patient has been enrolled the provider will be contacted to schedule shipment. Prolia® is shipped directly to the provider.
